One-Page Creed

*We orient ourselves toward the Sun,
the constant source of light, life, and rhythm.*

*We honor sunrise and sunset as sacred thresholds,
observed in silence and shared presence.*

We practice restraint, knowing that clarity requires limits.

*We respect silence as a common language,
and thought as a private act.*

*We recognize cannabis as a sacrament that may support reflection,
used intentionally, safely, and without excess.*

*We gather without coercion, hierarchy, or demand,
and depart without instruction.*

*We care for spaces of peace, light, and quiet,
so that reflection may continue beyond ourselves.*

*We give freely to sustain the practice,
knowing that continuity requires stewardship.*

*We claim no monopoly on truth,
only the discipline of return.*

Foundational Doctrine & Canon

The Observance is a religion of clarity, practiced in silence, anchored by the Sun, supported by community, and governed by restraint.

I. The Nature of the Divine

The Observance recognizes the Sun as the constant source of life, rhythm, and clarity. The Sun is not understood as a human-like being, but as that which makes life visible, time meaningful, and reflection possible. The Observance mirrors the Sun's impartiality through restraint and presence.

II. Purpose of the Religion

The purpose of The Observance is to cultivate clarity of mind and presence of being through silent reflection, alignment with natural cycles, and shared non-coercive practice. It exists to protect the conditions in which honest thought arises.

III. Sacred Times and Practice

Sunrise and sunset are recognized as sacred thresholds. These moments are observed in silence, without instruction, performance, or hierarchy. Silence is honored as the shared language of the community.

IV. Cannabis as Sacrament

The Observance recognizes cannabis as a sacrament that may be used intentionally to support mental stillness, perceptual clarity, and reflective awareness. Use is governed by restraint, safety, and personal responsibility. Abuse, excess, or endangerment contradicts the practice.

V. Safety and Restraint

Restraint is sacred. No practice is valid if it endangers others, compromises clarity, violates consent, or disrupts peace. Safety is an expression of reverence.

VI. Community and Participation

Participation is voluntary and non-proselytizing. No belief is required, and no experience must be shared. Community exists to witness presence, not to shape belief.

VII. Sacred Space

Quiet, natural light, and continuity are religious necessities. Coastal spaces are especially honored for their horizons and rhythmic alignment with sunrise and sunset. Land and buildings are containers for practice, not symbols of status.

VIII. Offerings and Support

The Observance is sustained by voluntary offerings given in gratitude for the continuation of the practice. Offerings support stewardship, preservation of quiet spaces, and continuity. No offering grants special access or authority.

IX. Stewardship and Leadership

Stewards protect silence, maintain continuity, care for spaces, and support practice. They do not prescribe belief or interpret experience.

X. Final Affirmation

The Observance claims no monopoly on truth and makes no promises of reward. It offers stillness, rhythm, and community grounded in repetition rather than belief.

Closing Declaration

The Observance exists whether or not it is attended. It continues whether or not it is explained. It is sustained not by belief, but by repetition.

Bylaws & Stewardship Charter

Article I — Purpose

These bylaws govern the stewardship, continuity, and administration of The Observance of the Sun, a religious organization devoted to contemplative observance of sunrise and sunset in silence. All governance exists solely to protect the practice and its sacred spaces.

Article II — Nonprofit and Religious Nature

The Observance of the Sun is organized exclusively for religious purposes. No part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any individual except as reasonable compensation for services rendered in furtherance of the religious mission.

Article III — Community and Participation

Participation in The Observance is voluntary and open. No belief, statement, or affirmation is required. The community exists to support presence, silence, and continuity of practice.

Article IV — Board of Stewards

The governing body of The Observance shall be the Board of Stewards. The Board shall consist of no fewer than three adults committed to the protection of the doctrine, practice, and sacred spaces. Stewards serve as custodians, not authorities.

Article V — Authority and Limits

The Board of Stewards shall have authority over organizational matters including finances, property, and appointments. The Board shall not interpret personal experiences, impose belief, or alter the Foundational Canon.

Article VI — Founder Role

The Founder is recognized as the originator of the practice and doctrine. The Founder may serve as a Steward or in an operational role, but holds no unilateral authority and is subject to the same governance standards as all Stewards.

Article VII — Stewardship Roles

Operational roles may include Organizer, Caretaker of Space, Volunteer Coordinator, and Administrator. Individuals serving in these roles may receive reasonable compensation approved by the Board.

Article VIII — Sacred Spaces

Land, buildings, and quiet environments are recognized as necessary containers for religious practice. The Board is entrusted with acquiring, maintaining, and protecting such spaces in alignment with the doctrine.

Article IX — Offerings and Finances

The Observance is sustained by voluntary offerings. No offering grants access, authority, or privilege. Financial records shall be maintained with clarity and restraint.

Article X — Amendments

These bylaws may be amended only by consensus or supermajority of the Board of Stewards, provided that no amendment may alter the Foundational Canon.

Article XI — Dissolution

Upon dissolution, all remaining assets shall be distributed to another religious or nonprofit organization aligned with contemplative, non-coercive practice.

Closing Stewardship Affirmation

*All authority within The Observance of the Sun exists to protect silence, continuity, and restraint.
Governance is a form of service. Stewardship is an act of reverence.*
